



## LOT CODE EXPLANATION

Our Lot Code is a unique, computer-generated number assigned to each and every batch that contains product identification numbers and production dates. Below are examples of our Lot Code structure:

Lot # = Product # + space + Plant Code + space + Manufacture Date (MMDDYY) and Batch letter (A, B, C, etc.)

AFF SF San Fernando (*Plant Identification Code 10*)

Lot # 010135 10 012125A

AFF Juice Division (*Plant Identification Code 20*)

Lot # 010135 20 091520A

AFF Flavor Division (*Plant Identification Code 30*)

Lot # C32830 30 091520A

Lot # C105830 30 091520A

AFFI (*Plant Identification Code 80*)

Lot # 010135 80 091520A

Lot # C105830 80 091520A

Lot # C32830 80 091520A

Below is an explanation of the method used to define the Lot Code for our products:

### **Lot Code format: C32830 80 091520A**

C328 – Product Identification Number (*Note: Juice Division products do not use letters in the identification number*)

30 – Internal Number (*Note: Juice Division products do not use internal numbers*)

80 – Plant Identification Code

091520 – Date Code (MM/DD/YY)

A – Sequential lettering for batches of the same product produced on the same day
